

Areas of Study for Dermal Fillers



1 Lip Fillers

Lip augmentation, correct asymmetry and enhance hydratation

2 Nasolabial Folds

Used to fill in and plump up the creases that we see running down the nose to the corner of the mouth called smile lines.

3 Marionette Lines

They work by providing extra fullness to the area where wrinkles are apparent.


4 Chin Fillers

Enhance its shape, definition, and overall appearance



Models for Practical Training

- Model Options: Bring your own model or let us arrange one for you.
